### **FOOL Fact!**

As part of the Oak Ridges Moraine, the Oak Hills and Oak Lake were designated as Areas of Natural and Scientific Interest [ANSI].

An ANSI is an official designation

by the <u>Government of Ontario</u> and is applied to geographical regions within the province that have unique <u>geological</u> or <u>ecological</u> features that represent land or water containing landscapes that are important for natural heritage, protection, appreciation, scientific study or education. Beginning in the 1960s and as of 2020, over 1000 sites within the province have been designated as such.

## **Residential Fire Safety**
